<i>Medicare Part B</i>	Medicare Part B provides coverage for breast, cervical and CVD screening.	N
<i>Medicare Part A</i>	If enrolled in Part A but <i>not</i> Part B, BCHP/WW remains “payer of last resort”.	Y
<i>None</i>	She is eligible to be enrolled in BCHP/WW provided she meets age and income eligibility guidelines.	Y
<i>Medicaid</i>	Medicaid does not cover <u>all</u> the costs of preventive health services. She is eligible provided she meets age eligibility guidelines. <u>Medicaid must be billed first. Payment to be held pending Medicaid denial.</u>	Y
<i>Private Insurance</i>	She is eligible to be enrolled provided she meets age and income eligibility guidelines <u>or</u> her insurance does not pay for grant services. (Ex: she has catastrophic insurance or preventive services are not covered). <u>Insurance must be billed first. Payment to be held pending insurance denial.</u>	Y
<i>IHS/ SEARHC Beneficiary</i>	She is eligible to be enrolled in BCHP/WW provided she meets age and <i>reportable</i> income eligibility guidelines. <u>Clinical services will be paid for by SEARHC.</u>	Y
<i>SEARHC Employee/ Dependent w/GWL</i>	In order to familiarize employees with the programs and to standardize employee health coverage, the employee and age-eligible dependents are provided courtesy services through the grants. <u>Clinical services will be paid by SEARHC.</u>	Y
<i>SEARHC Employee w/private insurance</i>	Is eligible for partial BCHP/WW services. <u>Clinical services will be paid by employee's private insurance.</u>	Y
